

Final Bulletin of the NuFact Summer School

August 7, 2006

Dates

The School sessions will run from Tuesday, August 15 through Wednesday, August 23. Saturday, August 19 is an open day – no School-related activities are scheduled.

Sessions begin at 8:30 am and end at 19:00 on most days, with a 2.5 hour mid-day break for lunch and study. See the detailed agenda for exceptions. We will finish early on Friday, August 18 (prior to the open day).

Arrival at UCLA

Students should check-in at the front desk of Dykstra-Deneve, located in Deneve Plaza at UCLA. The reception desk is open for check-in 24 hours. You are guaranteed that your room will be ready after 16:00 on August 14. The street address is:

If you are arriving by taxi or shuttle, use the address above.

If you are driving:

- Take the Sunset Village/UCLA exit from the Interstate 405 freeway.
- Stay on Sunset Blvd. until Bellagio Drive (one block after Veteran Drive).
- Turn RIGHT onto Bellagio Drive to enter campus (Bellagio dead-ends after one block, into DeNeve Drive).
- Turn RIGHT onto DeNeve Drive and follow this street around to Charles Young Drive.
- Turn RIGHT onto Charles Young Drive.
- Turn RIGHT immediately into Dykstra-DeNeve Plaza

If you are driving a car, you should park in the Dykstra/DeNeve (DD) Parking Garage. Permits are \$8.00/day and are not included in the registration fee. It is more convenient to get a one-week pass (so you don't have to change daily permits every day at 07:00am) but this takes a little advanced notice. If you would like to request permits for pick-up

Dykstra/DeNeve Plaza and the “DD” parking lot are shown in the red circle on the map below. The campus entrance via Bellagio Drive (described in the directions above) is indicated by the arrow in the upper left corner of the map.

NuFact Summer School Sessions at UCLA

The Summer School sessions will be held on the 6th floor of the UCLA Physics Department’s Knudsen Hall (marked with a purple circle on the map below). The lecture room is 6-107. To reach the Physics Building from the dormitory, simply go east down “Bruin Walk” until you are there. Ask a student for directions to “Physics and Astronomy” if you get lost.

Meals at UCLA

Your registration fee includes two meals per day. At UCLA, breakfast and dinner will be served in the dining hall of your dormitory. Breakfast hours are 07:00-09:00, and dinner hours are 17:00-20:00. Thus, you have about an hour to get dinner after the session ends.

Transportation to UC Irvine (Sunday, August 20)

The School will move to UC Irvine on the morning of Sunday, August 20. A shuttle van will leave the dormitory at 8:30 am – please be packed and ready to leave on time. If you have your own car, directions can be provided if necessary. Refreshments will be served on arrival at UC Irvine at around 10:00 am in 4135 Frederick Reines Hall, and the first lecture at UC Irvine will be begin at 10:30 am.

Boxed lunches will be provided at 12:30, and you can check in to your apartments at UCI during the lunch break. The afternoon session will begin at 15:00 and end at 18:00.

If you need parking at the UC Irvine Campus Apartments, it is available for \$7/day.

Summer School Sessions During the ISS

The International Scoping Study pre-meeting will begin on Monday, August 21 at UC Irvine. On Monday and Tuesday (August 21-22), both the ISS Meeting and the School will be held at the Beckman Center. The Beckman Center is within a short walk of the Campus Apartments; a shuttle will be available on request. Continental breakfast and a full lunch buffet will be served at the Beckman Center, along with the usual coffee breaks. School sessions on these days will be held on the second floor.

On the final day of the ISS and Summer School (Wednesday, August 23), School sessions will be held in 4135 Frederick Reines Hall. A continental breakfast and box lunch will be served, as well as the morning and afternoon breaks. The ISS meeting will be held in the Natural Sciences II building, less than 5 minutes away.
